Alcohol Policy

Gifted Things practices responsible service of alcohol. It is an offence to supply alcohol to or obtain alcohol on behalf of a person under the age of 18 years.

- If you are ordering a gift hamper containing alcohol, you must confirm that you are over 18 years old. It is a legal requirement that the person placing the order and the person receiving the delivery be over 18.
- We cannot deliver hampers containing alcohol to people under 18, and we may ask for identification to confirm this. We also can not leave hampers at an address where no one is home.
- Under Victorian law, we are not required to hold a liquor licence due to the Floristry and Gifting exemption.
- A liquor licence is not required to sell alcohol included in the sale of flowers or food designed to be delivered as a genuine gift to a person, such as a gift basket or bouquet provided:
 - All alcohol in the hamper must have been purchased from a retail liquor outlet.
 - Two litres is the maximum volume of alcohol permitted in each gift.
 - The gift must be packaged and presented so the recipient will consider it a gift.
 - The gift can only be delivered to another adult who is not the purchaser.
 - The gift cannot be delivered to a person at the location where the gift was purchased.
 - Gifts must be delivered between the hours of 7 am to 7 pm.
 - The value of the liquor and its container cannot exceed half of the purchase price of the gift.
